



Crediton Hall camping and caravan area

Camping area features: spacious grassy reserve around historic Crediton Hall.

Platypus viewing area beside the tranquil headwaters of Broken River.

Peaceful rural farming country with grazing cattle.

Abundant birdlife in rainforest pockets.

Location: 14.7 km south-east of Eungella on picturesque Crediton Loop Road.

Access: the camping area can be reached by conventional vehicles, caravans and on foot from the Mackay Highlands Great Walk.

Number of sites: open area without separately defined sites. Easy access for caravans. Maximum of 24 people.

Camp sites are suitable for: tent camping beside your car; self-contained caravans, walk-in camping.

Pet-friendly: domestic animals allowed if controlled and well-behaved.

Facilities: water (treat before drinking), composting toilets, covered picnic tables, gas BBQ. Limited power available for a small donation.

Essentials to bring: sufficient food and water, rubbish bags, insect repellent and sunscreen.

Bookings: Book upon arrival using the self-registration envelopes available from a dispenser at the toilet block.

Fees: \$5.00 per person per night, kids under 5 are free.

Mobile phone coverage: poor.
